

Who is our audience? Ages 6 – 106. We have learned that this show is not for toddlers and pre-school children as there is a good bit of dialogue. It works really well for both children (6 and up) and adults, but we like billing The Joshua Show as a family show.

What is the core audience insight? The world can seem like it's falling apart, especially with the daily bombardment of ugliness pouring out of our televisions and filling the pages of our newspapers. For so many, the answer is to disengage or even run away. However, we can all make a positive difference, and if we rely on our collective abilities, the world will change for the better. The Joshua Show believes that everyone has a superpower and that they can each be wielded to spread joy to the people around us.

What are the challenges with new audiences? Puppetry is often considered "just for kids," and people don't believe it can captivate adults. The Joshua Show is a platform to educate, entertain, and delight audiences of all ages. The revelation is that adults are captivated just as much (or more than) their kids. People sometimes view puppetry as a nostalgic art form or one that is tired and out of place in a predominantly digital world. The truth is, there is an incredible resurgence of puppetry, and The Joshua Show is a major part of re-imagining the way the world sees it.
