lan and Eleanor Carney were both born and raised in New Orleans and met at the age of 13 through ballet class. Their successful dancing careers took them to New York, and it was on Broadway when Ian met co-creator Corbin Popp, while dancing in Twyla Tharp's Movin' Out. An immediate connection was made between the kindred spirits as they discovered their mutual love of art, theater, and technology. After coming across a product called, "EL Wire," the lights turned on and the possibilities seemed endless. Together, with their wives, Eleanor, and Whitney, they began to experiment with shapes and designs to develop puppetry-based neon creatures that quickly came to life.

After years of engineering and development, they initially founded CORBIAN Visual Arts and Dance. Although New York offered many opportunities, Ian and Eleanor wanted to return to New Orleans shortly after Hurricane Katrina hit their hometown. With the hopes of helping to rebuild their city, they were joined by Corbin and Whitney Popp and eventually founded Lightwire Theater.

Since then, they have become internationally recognized for their signature brand of electroluminescent artistry, poignant storytelling and music scores designed to evoke imagery. Lightwire Theater continues to create and deliver innovative theatrical experiences to audiences worldwide based out of New Orleans, LA.



THE BUILD

The process of building Lightwire Theater's electroluminescent characters starts with the creators and the cast. They build everything themselves from the ground up, with each sculpture taking nearly 200 hours of intensive labor. The foundation begins with a base that includes triggers and armatures. They utilize recyclable materials including aluminum rods, election signs, skateboard wheels, dryer ducts, plumbing supplies, PVC pipes, fishing poles, duct tape, zip ties, and back packs to help define peaks and angles. These common household items help create durable and pliable sculptures that can withstand the movement of the dancers and multiple performances. Black fabric is added to the sculpture for dimension and then lined with electroluminescent wire known as "EL Wire" which is soldered everywhere the wire is connected. Unlike black lights, "EL Wire" can be powered by batteries, requires no theatrical lighting, and gives 360-degrees of glowing light. Once the character is "turned on" it can use up to a 16AA or rechargeable batteries per performance. The result…anything your inner-child can dream of, including 16-ft. tall birds, dinosaurs, ducks, soldiers, swords and more!


















THE TEAM



IAN CARNEY

(Creator, Artistic Director & Choreographer)

lan Carney, a New Orleans native, is best known for his long run in Billy Joel and Twyla Tharp's musical, Movin' Out on Broadway. Born in New Hampshire and raised in New Orleans, he began dancing as a child, studying ballet with Harvey Hysell and Diane Carney in New Orleans and New York City. He danced lead roles in The Nutcracker, Sleeping Beauty, and many other ballets, as well as being a guest dancer, teacher, and choreographer in companies across the United States. While still performing, he earned a degree in English Literature from Tulane University.

He is the co-creator of Dino-Light, Lightwire Theater's first feature length theatrical production, that continues to captivate audiences around the world. Ian has also appeared on television with Lightwire Theater, including season 7 of America's Got Talent, Italy's hit show, Tú Sí Que Vales, TF1's The Best: Le Meilleur Artiste in France, and truTv's Fake Off, where they won the competition. Most recently, Lightwire Theater was featured on Fox Television's Game of Talents.

Carney is a talented and versatile performer who has made significant contributions to the world of dance and theater. He is an inspiration to many, and his work continues to entertain and delight audiences of all ages.



ELEANOR B. CARNEY

(Creator & Executive Director)

Eleanor Bernard Carney is co-founder, dancer and director of Lightwire Theater, a company that creates electroluminescent theatrical experiences for global audiences. She began her dance training in New Orleans and graduated from Southern Methodist University with a BFA in Dance and a BA in Anthropology. She has danced professionally with several ballet companies, including the Indianapolis Ballet Theater and the Lexington, Northwest Florida, Delta Festival, and Montgomery Ballets.

Eleanor has danced many lead roles, including Aurora in Sleeping Beauty, Desdemona in The Moor's Pavane, Romeo and Juliet, Cinderella, Giselle, Coppelia, and the Sugarplum Fairy in The Nutcracker. She has also appeared with Lightwire Theater on Season 7, semi-finals of America's Got Talent, Italy's hit show, Tú Sí Que Vales, TF1's The Best: Le Meilleur Artiste in France, 2014 winner of TruTV's Fake Off and most recently appeared, on Fox Television's Game of Talents.

She continues to tour the world with the company, illuminating the stage with her husband and passion for storytelling, light, movement, and imagination. Lightwire's performances magically erase the dancer, allowing the fantastical creatures and original productions to come to life. Eleanor's work is essential to this magic, and her passion inspires audiences of all ages.



CORBIN POPP

(Creator & Technical Supervisor)

Corbin is from Lincoln, Nebraska. He earned a degree in biochemistry at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. As a Fulbright Scholar, Corbin pursued a dance career leading him across the globe as a concert and Broadway performer. Corbin performed with The Sacrament Ballet, and Complexions. His Broadway credits include both The Phantom of the Opera, and Billy Joel and Twyla Tharp's Movin' Out.

Following his Broadway career, he teamed up with his longtime friend, Ian Carney, to create the preforming company CORBiAN Performing Arts, which led way to Lightwire Theater as we know it today. Corbin returned to scholastics in 2009 and is now helping people smile as a Biological Dentist. He is owner of Colorado Biodental and Esthetics, in Littleton Colorado. His wife and he have three beautiful children, and the whole family enjoys every moment to reconnect with Lightwire Theater.



WHITNEY POPP

(Creator)

Whitney began training with Mid Columbia Ballet in Washington, and later trained at Pacific Northwest Ballet. She then spent 5 years as a principal dancer with Sacramento Ballet performing many lead roles such as Odette/Odile in Swan Lake, leads in numerous Balanchine ballets, and the Cowgirl in Agnes de Milles Rodeo, just to name a few. Whitney was chosen to perform in many works by outstanding choreographers as well, such as Dwight Rhoden, Amy Siewert, and Val Cannaparoli. After moving to New York, she was discovered by Twyla Tharp and joined Twyla Tharp Dance.

Whitney toured Europe with Twyla Tharp Dance and went on to become one of Twyla's leading principals for the creation of several new works. Whitney also joined the 1st Nat'l Broadway tour of Movin' Out performing multiple lead roles. She later toured Europe once again, this time with her husband Corbin, performing more works by Twyla Tharp. Whitney has had the privilege of teaching all over the world and lives in Colorado with her husband and their three children. She is a proud faculty member of Colorado Ballet Academy. Whitney is also a co-founder of the performing company Lightwire Theater based in New Orleans that finished in the semi finals of America's Got Talent in 2013.
